



## Canadian Global Oncology Workshop - Abstract Competition

The 2023 Canadian Global Oncology Workshop will be held in Calgary, Alberta on December 1 and 2, 2023. As part of this year's workshop, we will highlight 5 global oncology projects that have a positive impact on cancer control in low- and middle-income countries.

### **Eligibility Criteria:**

1. Any scientist, healthcare professional or allied healthcare professional working in the field of cancer may apply.
2. Collaborative research / service delivery in which the applicant has been significantly involved, in global cancer control, focusing on positive impact in low and middle income countries.
3. The project may be clinical or scientific.
4. Work may have been published previously (but not before 2023).

### **Abstract guidelines**

- 300 words maximum, including background, methods, results and discussion.
- Submissions are open to any discipline involved in cancer control. The judges (who will be from a geographically diverse background and from different disciplines) are to be briefed regarding marking criteria, such that the impact of the research is judged within the context of the resources available to the host institution.

### **Abstract deadline**

October 15<sup>th</sup>, 2023

The top 5 abstracts will present their findings in a rapid abstract session on **December 2, 2023 (5-minute presentation followed by 2-minute question and answer)**.

Successful abstract presenters will be notified by email by November 10, 2023. All other submitted abstracts will be invited to display a virtual poster at the workshop.

The winners must agree to attend the conference in person or virtually to present the work.
