

MEDICAL ONCOLOGIST (FULL-TIME)

Cambridge Memorial Hospital (CMH) along with Grand River Regional Cancer Centre/Waterloo Wellington (GRRCC) is currently recruiting for a shared 1.0 full time equivalent (FTE) Alternate Payment plan (APP) Medical Oncology position.

Cambridge Memorial Hospital and GRRCC provide a full service of comprehensive cancer treatments to the 700,000 residents in the Waterloo Region, Wellington County and the surrounding area.

The successful applicant would join the Medical Oncology teams at Cambridge Memorial Hospital and the Grand River Regional Cancer in providing specialized oncology services including the delivery of chemotherapy and participation in clinical trials. The successful applicant should demonstrate a passion for quality improvement as well as an interest in Medical leadership.

The duties would include regular outpatient oncology clinics that will be divided between CMH and GRRCC depending on clinical need, which would include participation in outpatient emergency clinics or assistance with coverage of other oncologists. Opportunities for teaching with the Satellite McMaster University Faculty of Health Sciences are available and encouraged, with a stream of clerks, residents and fellows regularly rotating through the program.

Certification in Medical Oncology by the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada, and eligibility for independent licensure in the Province of Ontario are required. The successful applicant must also obtain and maintain privileges at Cambridge Memorial Hospital, Grand River Hospital and other associated hospitals in the region as required.
